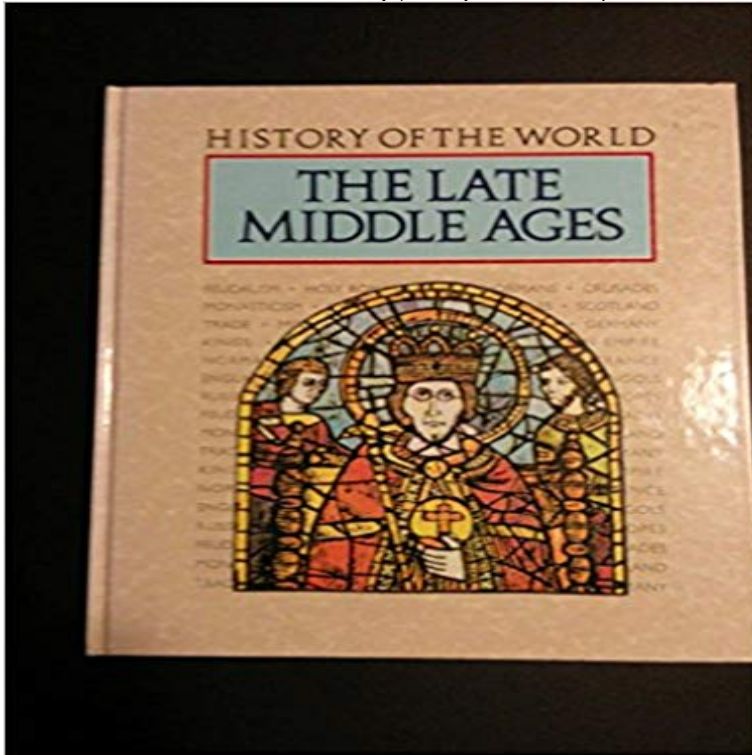


## The Late Middle Ages (History of the World)
